Order Compelling Compliance

Defense motion to declare defendant indigent for costs granted.

Defense is to utilize electronic court reporting services and Broward Sheriff's office for service of subpoenas, or other state officers. The Sheriff shall allow the Defendant use of telephones at no cost and not requiring collect calls so that Defendant may set hearing, deposition and aid and assisting within investigation, etc. and other matters relates solely to his cases.

The Defendant was deemed indigent for his costs, this court hereby sanctions the Broward County Main Jail, and F.D.O.C. against any further fees, and orders the Broward Sheriff's office to refund any and all charges of fees because Defendant is a state prisoner already deemed indigent.

The court hereby orders the main jail to comply allowing the defendant to attend the law library consistent with respect to due process rights and Constitutional laws, which Defendant may research on the laws, make copies, have access to telephone calls, without any further impediment, in Broward County main jail, and the Florida Department of Corrections, access to normal ink pens and typewriter/computer etc.

The court further orders release of Defendant contact card, and receipts to Defendant and his attorney's, etc. and his investigators under chapter 119, and other discovery rules to release Defendant's personal property to his attorneys etc. and his investigators as soon as possible. And any further records which are being withheld from the defense. Any further delay which may deem as additional breach of duty.
