Jurisdiction in this case is invoked under: Article (1) Section (7), and Federal Jurisdiction is invoked under: 42, U.S.C. § 1983, 42, U.S.C. § 1985, 42, U.S.C. § 1986, 28, U.S.C.A. § 1367.

- 1). Broward County Sheriff's main Jail, officials, and their Deputies bias retaliative practice, and EXCESSIVE Security measures and Shacking present Creating deliberate indifference against plaintiff legal court proceedings which causation of infringement and continuously delay and hindering the preparation of plaintiff pro-se. cases, and otherwise.
- 2). There is illegal hinderance from litigation and proper communication at times, deprivation of plaintiff due process rights, and violation of plaintiff constitutional rights, and violation of plaintiff international rights under the color of Law. in contrary to allow plaintiff access to proper communicating with Consular of Jamaica, on the free legal Telephone at times to follow-up on petitioner legality issues, and international rights.

- 4). Broward Sheriff's legal affair office Advised plaintiff that the Reality is, Complainant is the Adversed party, so they cannot Tell their employees to follow the Laws, when the adverse party gain from such Rules or orders, etc.
- 5). Plaintiff was declare indigent for costs to proceed on case Numbers: "05-018672 (11) civil action" and Criminal case no.: 90-13414 cf10B / 90-5417cf10B. which the Respondents actions - caused prejudicial errors, and additional misconduct.
